The ports of entry by air are the Norman Manley International Airport in Kingston (NMIA - KIN) and the Donald Sangster International Airport in Montego Bay. (DSIA - MBJ). Please note that travel from Montego Bay to Kingston is approximately four hours by land and so participants may choose to fly directly to Kingston. Each participant is responsible for his/her own transportation to and from the Airport, but contact can be made with the College for recommendations of approved travel services.
