#### ON CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation is available on campus at the Scarlett Hall of Residence for international groups of children 13 years and older at a cost of **US** \$450.00 for the month or **US\$250.00** or two weeks. Meals are not included in the cost, but cooking facilities are available on each block and food can be bought at the College's Cafeteria. Each child or group of children must come with their own chaperone, own bed linens and toiletries. Our Hall is gated and boasts all the amenities of first-class student living with 24-hour security, laundry facilities, WIFI and parking. Reservations must be made at the same time of registration.

### TRAVEL DETAILS

The ports of entry by air are the Norman Manley International Airport in Kingston (NMIA - KIN) and the Donald Sangster International Airport in Montego Bay. (DSIA - MBJ). Please note that the journey from Montego Bay to Kingston is approximately four hours by land and so participants may choose to fly directly to Kingston. Each participant is responsible for his/her own transportation to and from the Airport, but contact can be made with the College for recommendations of approved travel services.
