

BACHELOR OF ART EDUCATION

The goal of the Art Education Department is to prepare students for a professional career in education. Students are challenged and supported to excel in an extremely demanding and incredibly rewarding career as a teacher. Being a good artist is essential to being a good art teacher. To qualify for the BAE students are required to complete a minimum of 140 credits; including 10 credits of electives over four (4) years.

Students must complete:

- 24 Credits in Studio I (specialization) including Drawing in Years 2 and 3.
- 12 Credits in Studio II in Years 2 and 3.
- 2 Credits of Art Education Professional Studies in Year 2.
- 21 Credit of Art Education Professional Studies in Year 3 inclusive of 3 credits of Practicum.
- 27 Credits of Art Education Professional Studies in Year 4 inclusive of 12 credits for Practicum and Service Learning project.
- 8 Credits of Art History,
- 18 Credits in General Studies
- 10 credits of electives over 4 years
