### MINIMUM QUALIFICATION & KNOWLEDGE/ SKILLS

- MA/MFA in Drama in Education, Drama/Theatre Education, or related MA/MFA
- A minimum of 5 years teaching experience, preferably at the post secondary level
- Design and delivery of drama/theatre curricula for students with learning exceptionalities
- A practicing performer, theatre-maker, drama educator, theatre and/or cultural researcher
- Relevant experience in teaching at the tertiary level
- Proven ability to devise, advise and manage learning programmes
- Ability to creatively design teaching and learning material
- Ability to employ appropriate assessment methods
- Open-minded and flexible attitude
- Capacity to work well under pressure and to cope with extended/unpredictable hours
- Creative flair

- Undergraduate academic training in theatre, and tertiary level practice in theatre-making
